Environmental photojournalist and former *Boston Globe* reporter David Arnold wondered how global warming may have altered the icy landscapes photographed in the 1930s by Bradford Washburn, founding director of the Museum of Science. In 2005, he began retracing Washburn's steps and re-shooting these photographs from the same angles and vantage points the pioneering mountaineer had used decades earlier. Although Arnold captured the same terrain, the recent images are vastly different and provide powerful evidence of how our planet is changing.
